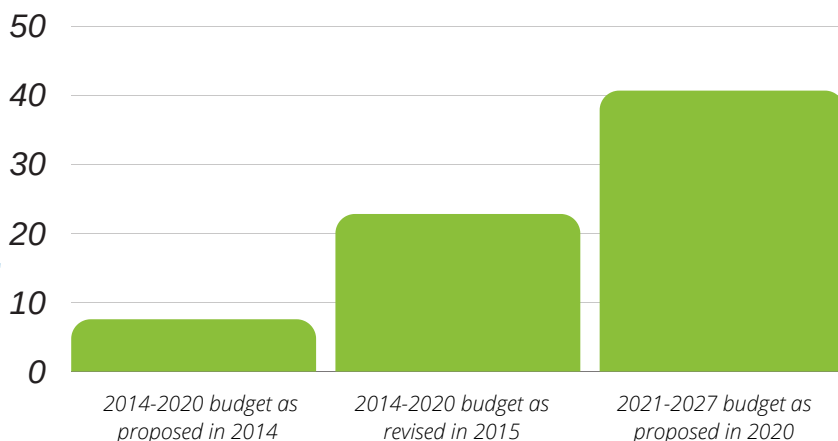


State of play 1/2

1- The EU migration management budget increases

Across all instruments:
2020 proposal: **EUR 40 billion**
Compared to **EUR 7.5 billion in 2014***

*2018 prices



2- Migration management within the EU



EUR 31.12 billion available for the **internal dimension of migration**, of which:



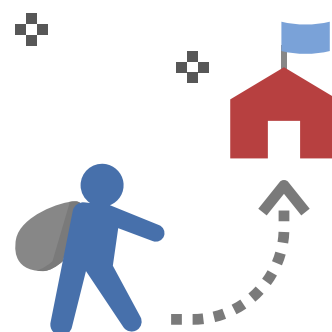
3/4 goes to return and police border management*

*Spread across the Asylum and Migration Fund, the Integrated Border Management Fund and decentralised agencies such as the European Border and Coast Guard Agency (Frontex)



1/4 only supports asylum procedures and integration*

*Spread in the 2021-2027 budget proposal across the European Asylum Support Office and the Asylum and Migration Fund

3- Migration management outside the EU

At least **10%** of the NDICI*
*Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument

5% of the AMF*
*Asylum and Migration Fund, based on European Parliament proposal

2% of the IBMF*
*Integrated Border Management Fund, based on European Parliament proposal

EUR 9.5 billion to reduce arrivals and increase returns

Lack of transparency and accountability

Supporting violent and oppressive regimes in the name of migration controls



More pushbacks of migrants and refugees

Likely to increase violence at borders

Development aid to third countries conditioned to their migration policies
