Frequent at sea
(but conditional upon signalling)

Systematic on land

Always subject to a missing persons report by the family:

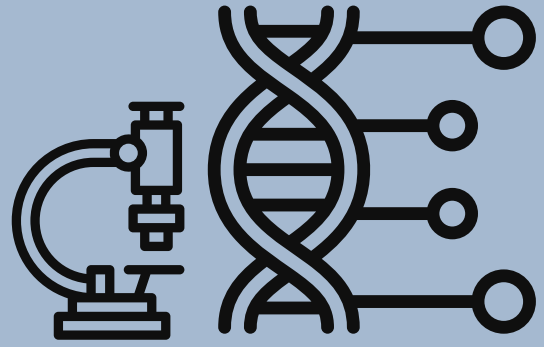
- **Frequent** identification procedures for nationals
- **Occasional** identification procedures for foreigners

Individualisation of burials, tracing and location: no information

Repatriation of bodies: no information

Issue of death certificates: systematic
