


Morocco: managing the bodies of people who have died or disappeared during migration

There are significant differences between regions. Practices are more structured in urban areas. However, there are no national standards in Morocco.



Always subject to a missing persons report by the family:


- · Occasional identification procedures for nationals
- **Occasional** identification procedures for foreigners



Data collection

Data collection frequent (dependent on local context)

Occasional autopsies



Collection and archiving of post-mortem data: frequent (depending on the local context)

Burials

Individualisation of burials: occasional and dependent on local context

Tracing and location: no information

Repatriation of bodies: occasional

Issue of death certificates: frequent and conditional on the family request

Body search systems

For nationals: no information For foreigners: no information
